





#### Gross Patient Revenue-Q3 YTD FY24






### Operating Income-Q3 YTD FY24

# Cash & Cash Equivalents-Q3 YTD FY24






### Charity Care & Bad Debt-Q3 YTD FY24







# Salaries, Wages, & Benefits (in thousands)




# Total Operating Revenue (in thousands)

Yes – 2899 (66.2%)


No – 1479 (43.8%)
