Dear Ms. Cooper:

I write in support of the introduction and passage of ordinance 2015-12. The improvements in consistency, clarity and organization of the ordinance make for better governance for the administration, the assembly **and** the property owners affected by the USAD process.

Establishing the percentage of property owners required to move a project forward to at least 60 percent of those affected is a standard that I recommend you approve.

I do note, however, that under state law, all that is required is the support of 50 percent of property owners. As in bond propositions or sales and property tax propositions the standard for approval is also a simple majority.

Nonetheless, I fully support the borough's ability to set the standard at 60 percent for the formation of a USAD.

I hope you can enlist the support of your fellow assembly members in the passage of this ordinance.
