2025 (Mayor)

The resolution establishes the property tax rates for Fiscal Year 2026 (FY2026), Tax Year 2025. The tax revenue generated from these rates will provide the largest single source of funding for the borough's FY2026 budget. The mill rate for FY2026 must be set prior to June 15, 2025. Action on the resolution is being requested for the meeting of June 3, 2025.
