The Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (DHS&EM) is pleased to announce the final award allocations for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP), State Homeland Security Program (SHSP). The total award amount for each successful local jurisdiction is included as an attachment with this electronic notification. Grant award letters with Project Budget Details (PBDs) will be mailed out shortly.

The US Department of Homeland Security FY 2016 HSGP is one tool among a comprehensive set of measures authorized by Congress and implemented by the Administration to help strengthen the Nation against risks associated with potential terrorist attacks and the larger, coordinated effort to strengthen homeland security preparedness. This program implements objectives addressed in a series of post-9/11 laws, strategy documents, plans, and Homeland Security Presidential Directives (HSPDs).

The local signatory official from each jurisdiction will receive a certified packet containing the SHSP grant award, approved projects, and any applicable attachments. Other identified points of contact will receive a copy of the packet by regular mail. Please note, attendance by programmatic and financial representatives at a Grant Kickoff Meeting, to be held in the fall is mandatory for jurisdictions receiving awards. A separate message will be sent with information regarding these meetings.
