### MEMORANDUM

**RE:** Ordinance 2016-18: Waiving the Right to Protest the State of Alaska's Issuance of Certain Marijuana Cultivation Licenses

---

As of this date, the state has provided four additional marijuana cultivation license applications to the borough for consideration. Instead of listing individual pending license applications, I propose to amend Section 1 of this ordinance to include the objective criteria of applications meeting borough standards that were received prior to enactment of this ordinance.

- Move to amend Section 1 by deleting the capitalized and italicized language and inserting the underlined language (all in bold) as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to 3 AAC 306.075 the KPB assembly hereby waives its right to protest the state's grant of the **[FOLLOWING]** marijuana cultivation license applications **[:] that the state has found complete and submitted to the borough for review on or before the effective date of this ordinance, that the borough administration has determined do not violate the standards in KPB 7.30.020 A - C, and that are scheduled to be considered by the Marijuana Control Board during its meeting of June 9, 2016. [PEACE FROG BOTANICALS, LLC, OMAR GUCER DBA TALISMAN FARMS, CROY'S ENTERPRISES, LLC AND GREATLAND GANJA, LLC AND]** **The KPB assembly** suspends the requirements of KPB 7.30.010 and KPB 7.30.020 A.1. only for these initial license applications. The waiver only applies to this first application year.
