SECTION 15. That Proposition No. 1, Central Peninsula Landfill General Obligation Bonds, was ratified by the voters of the borough.


SECTION 16. That Proposition No. 2, South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area General Obligation Bonds, was ratified by the voters of the borough.

SECTION 17. That Proposition No. 3, Increasing the Sales Tax Cap from \$500 to \$1000, was defeated by the voters of the borough.




SECTION 19. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
