RE:	LAYDOWN Johnson Amendment to Resolution 2025-021, Determining the Amount to be Provided from Local Sources for School Purposes During Fiscal Year 2026 and Approving the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District Total Budget (Mayor)	

This amendment will change the total of local funding for education from \$57,634,015 to \$62,359,080 which is the Kenai Peninsula Borough contribution amount requested by the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District for fiscal year 2026. This will increase the Mayor's proposed education budget by \$4,725,065 for fiscal year 2026.
