- WHEREAS,** the Nikiski High School Girls' Volleyball team is the 2024 Alaska Class 3A State Champion, having won the State title at the Alaska Airlines Center in Anchorage on Saturday, November 16th, 2024; and
- WHEREAS,** the team showed incredible determination and resilience by coming back from a first-round loss to defeat the Kenai Central High School Cardinals in the final, securing a 30-27 victory in a thrilling championship match; and
- WHEREAS,** the team's victory in the double-elimination tournament was marked by impressive set scores of 25-22, 27-25, 25-21, and the decisive final set of 30-27; and

- WHEREAS,** the Nikiski Volleyball team's championship victory is a testament to the dedication, teamwork, and sportsmanship of the players, coaches, and school community.

SECTION 3. That a special Certificate of Achievement will be presented to each member of the Nikiski High School Girls' volleyball team with the commendation of the Assembly.



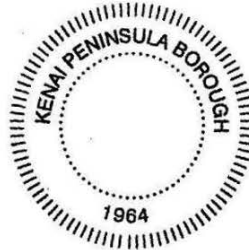
