## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 2014-066

## A RESOLUTION ASKING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME TO COMPLETE THE 2014 KASILOF RIVER SOCKEYE SMOLT ENUMERATION PROJECT AND TO CONTINUE THAT PROJECT IN THE FUTURE

- WHEREAS, the Kasilof River sockeye run is important both to the economy of the Kenai Peninsula Borough and to commercial, personal use and sport fisheries; and
- WHEREAS, any disease or fresh water survival problems for sockeye will appear in smolt migration numbers two or three years before the problem can be recognized in adult returns; and
- WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) has, together with Cook Inlet Aquaculture Association, counted Kasilof River sockeye smolt out-migration numbers for most years since 1980; and
- WHEREAS, after receiving a KPB Resolution requesting funding for a 2014 Kasilof River sockeye out-smolt enumeration project, the Alaska State Legislature gave a grant of \$25,000 to Cook Inlet Aquaculture Association to perform the field work part of said study; and
- WHEREAS, an additional \$10,000 is needed to do the lab work and to analyze the data for the information collected in the 2014 season sockeye smolt count; and
- WHEREAS, the ADF&G predicts sockeye annual returns for the Kasilof River and uses smolt enumeration estimates in those calculations; and
- WHEREAS, sockeye predictions are very useful for fishers, for salmon processors, and for biologists;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

**SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly asks the State of Alaska and the Alaska Department of Fish and Game to provide the \$10,000 needed to fund the analysis portion of the 2014 Kasilof River sockeye smolt enumeration.

**SECTION 2.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly asks the Alaska Department of Fish and Game to perform sockeye out-migration enumerations in the Kasilof River in 2015.

**SECTION 3.** That a copy of this resolution shall be provided to the Kenai Peninsula Borough legislative delegation and the Commissioner of ADF&G.

**SECTION 4.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon adoption.
