- **WHEREAS**, with the passing of Stan Thompson, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has lost an esteemed member of our community; and

- **WHEREAS**, Stan Thompson prospected, commercial fished, homesteaded, owned small businesses, and contributed to the development of Alaska through a lifetime of hard work and tenacity; and
- **WHEREAS**, Stan served as Kenai Peninsula Borough Mayor for ten years, from 1972-1975 and 1980-1987; and
- **WHEREAS**, during his tenure as Borough Mayor, Mr. Thompson integrated the use of computer technology into borough functions, his expansive vision paving the way for the development of our advanced GIS mapping capacities; and
- WHEREAS, Stan Thompson—along with his beloved wife of 61 years, Donnis —was a vital and significant facet of the development of the Kenai Peninsula Borough. His insight, commitment to service, and keen intelligence have shaped and influenced the Kenai Peninsula Borough irrevocably. Stan Thompson will be missed deeply by his family and community, and all who knew him are saddened by his passing;
