1 **CITY OF HOMER** 2 HOMER, ALASKA Mayor/Council 3 **RESOLUTION 16-068** 4 5 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 6 EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH 7 ORDINANCE 2016-16, SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS A BALLOT 8 PROPOSITION THAT INCREASES THE SALES TAX CAP FROM \$500 9 TO \$1,000 AND EXEMPTS RESIDENTIAL RENTS FROM SALES TAX. 10 11 WHEREAS, The decline in state programs and financial assistance to municipalities 12 resulted in cuts to the City of Homer operating budget and suspension of dedicated sales tax 13 14 for roads, HART, until 2019 to cover the gap; and 15 WHEREAS. Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 2016-16 increases the sales tax cap 16 from \$500 to \$1,000 borough-wide and exempts residential rent from sales tax, subject to 17 18 voter approval; and 19 WHEREAS. The Kenai Peninsula Borough estimates that the increase in sales tax cap 20 21 coupled with the exemption of residential rent would generate approximately \$190,000 in increased sales tax returns for the City of Homer; and 22 23 WHEREAS. Small revenue increases from multiple sources, combined with careful 24 spending will be needed to balance the budget by 2019; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, The sales tax cap has not been adjusted in over 50 years; and 28 29 WHEREAS, Increasing the cap Borough-wide keeps the playing field level for peninsula 30 businesses. 31 32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, expresses support for KPB Ordinance 2016-16, submitting to the voters a ballot proposition that 33 increases the sales tax cap from \$500 to \$1,000 and exempts residential rent. 34 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Homer City Clerk is instructed to transmit a copy of 36 37 the resolution to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Mayor and Assembly. 38 PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Homer City Council this 13th day of June, 2016. 39
