


Deficit Spending

- FY15: \$1,147,325 (after \$1,254,000 in budget reductions)
- FY16: \$1,137,600 (after \$1,375,000 in budget reductions)
- FY17: \$2,241,628 (after \$2,534,393 in budget reductions)
 - ► Also an additional \$900,000 in lapse included beyond listed reductions
- ► FY18: Anticipate more reductions and deficit spending

FY 18 Budget Process

- December 2016: Review various funding scenarios and ramifications
- January 2017: Preliminary budget recommendation to School Board
- February 2017: Regional Budget Forums and Key Communicators
- March 2017: FY18 Budget Recommendation to School Board
- ► April 2017: FY18 Budget approval with transmittal to Borough
