RE: Resolution 2021-030, Accepting Emergency Response Equipment from the Southern Region Emergency Medical Services Council, Inc. on Behalf of the Anchor Point Fire & Emergency Medical Service Area and Recognizing the Transfer of Assets to the Western Emergency Service Area (Mayor)

Southern Region Emergency Medical Services Council, Inc., ("Southern Region") is a nonprofit corporation that serves as a resource center for emergency medical response agencies located in low to moderate income, rural communities.

Anchor Point Fire & Emergency Medical Service Area (APFEMSA) received notification from Southern Region for purchase of equipment under the Code Blue program. The approved equipment included one transport insert, stretcher system for an all-terrain vehicle response unit and one power gurney unit. Southern Region purchased the equipment on behalf of the service area; however, APFEMSA experienced delivery delays due to the pandemic.

APFEMSA provided the match requirement; the match amounts vary for each purchase because Southern Region had limited funding available (see chart below). As the APFEMSA recently expanded and is now the Western Emergency Service Area ("WESA"), the WESA service area board will make recommendations on accepting the equipment at its April 14, 2021 meeting.
