**RE:** LAYDOWN Amendments to Ordinance 2023-19-12, Appropriating \$175,000 from the General Fund Balance for a Professional Study Concerning High Water Issues in the K-Beach Area (Mayor)

---

The planning commission voted unanimously to forward to the assembly a recommendation to adopt the following ordinance with the following amendment

1. Ordinance 2023-19-12: Appropriating \$175,000 from the General Fund balance for a professional study for concerning high water issues in the K-Beach area ***and to use \$25,000 of this amount to purchase water monitoring equipment*** .

### Three recommended amendments to Ordinance 2023-19-12

[Please note the bold underlined language is new and the strikeout language in brackets is to be deleted.]

- Amend the title of the ordinance to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$175,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND  
BALANCE FOR A PROFESSIONAL STUDY FOR CONCERNING HIGH WATER  
ISSUES IN THE K-BEACH AREA **AND TO PURCHASE MINOR WATER  
MONITORING EQUIPMENT**

- Amend the 9<sup>th</sup> whereas to read as follows:

**WHEREAS,** at its meeting on **August 14, 2023**, the Planning Commission recommended **approval** of the ordinance **and recommended amending the ordinance to include authorization to use \$25,000 of the project funds to purchase minor monitoring equipment;**

- Amend Section 1 of the Ordinance to read as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of \$175,000 is appropriated from the General Fund fund balance to be transferred to account 100.21110.24SDY.49999 for the purpose of securing professional engineering or hydrological service for a study and long-term solution recommendations for the high water issues in the Kalifonsky Beach area **and for the purchase of minor water monitoring equipment to accommodate the study and provide beneficial data for purposes of long-term solution recommendation(s).**
