## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2016-19-14

## AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$75,000 FROM THE SEWARD/BEAR CREEK FLOOD SERVICE AREA FUND BALANCE TO COMPLETE REPAIR AND RECOVERY WORK ON BOX CANYON CREEK, SAWMILL CREEK AND TWO SITES ON SALMON CREEK NEAR SEWARD, ALASKA

- WHEREAS, the mission of the Seward Bear Creek Flood Service Area ("SBCFSA") is to provide flood planning, protection, and mitigation services in coordination with appropriate agencies to reduce the risk of flood damage to private and public property through addressing issues that best reflect a fair use of the tax levy for watershed wide benefit; and
- WHEREAS, the Seward area received over 4 inches of rain in forty-eight hours during the week of September 20, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, gravel embankments at four critical sites including one each on Box Canyon Creek and Sawmill Creek and two sites on Salmon Creek were eroded or breached; and
- WHEREAS, additional storms could cause further damage to the river banks, infrastructure, public and private property; and
- WHEREAS, the SBCFSA Board at the October 3, 2016, regular meeting approved up to \$75,000 from fund balance to complete recovery work on Box Canyon Creek, Sawmill Creek and two sites on Salmon Creek;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That \$75,000.00 is appropriated from the Seward/Bear Creek fund balance account 259.00000.00000.27910 to account 259.21212.00000.43011, Contract Services, for costs associated with recovery work on Box Canyon Creek, Sawmill Creek, and two sites on Salmon Creek.
- **SECTION 2**. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
