**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING ALLIE OSTRANDER FOR HER OUTSTANDING  
ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENTS AND HER INDUCTION INTO THE ALASKA SPORTS  
HALL OF FAME**

- WHEREAS,** Allie Ostrander, a Kenai Peninsula Borough School District alum, has distinguished herself through exceptional achievements in athletics, specifically in the disciplines of cross-country and track and field; and
- WHEREAS,** Allie’s remarkable talent was evident early in her career, beginning with her unprecedented victories in the Alaska high school sports arena, where she secured multiple state championships and set numerous records; and
- WHEREAS,** her athletic prowess continued to flourish at Boise State University, where she earned multiple NCAA titles and garnered national recognition for her exceptional skills and sportsmanship; and
- WHEREAS,** Allie Ostrander has not only excelled in collegiate athletics but has also shone brightly on national and international stages, representing our community and state with distinction and honor; and
- WHEREAS,** her induction into the Alaska Sports Hall of Fame is a testament to her dedication, perseverance, and excellence, bringing pride to the Kenai Peninsula Borough and serving as an inspiration to young athletes across Alaska and beyond; and
- WHEREAS,** Allie’s commitment to community and her role as a mentor to aspiring athletes exemplifies the highest ideals of sportsmanship and community engagement; and
- WHEREAS,** her achievements have significantly contributed to the promotion and recognition of Alaskan athletes on the world stage, thereby enhancing the reputation of Alaska’s athletic programs; and
- WHEREAS,** in her senior year of high school alone, on her way to becoming one of the most sought-after high school stars in the nation, Allie won the Nike Cross Country National Championship, won 36 of the 40 races she competed in during her senior year of track and field, and her time of 9 minutes, 58.74 second in the 3,200 meters registered as the second-best high school time in the country; and

**WHEREAS,** all told, Allie earned 10 state titles over a four-year span as a Kenai Kardinal, was named Gatorade Player of the Year four times, has four school records in track and won six titles in Alaska’s famed Mount Marathon race;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly recognizes and commends Allie Ostrander for her outstanding athletic achievements and her well-deserved induction into the Alaska Sports Hall of Fame.

**SECTION 2.** That a copy of this will be presented to Allie Ostrander with the sincere appreciation, profound thanks, and best wishes of the Assembly.

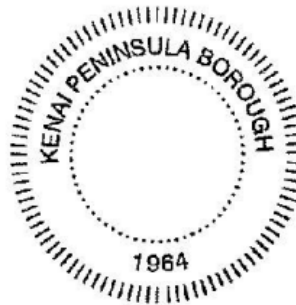
**SECTION 3.** This resolution becomes effective immediately.
