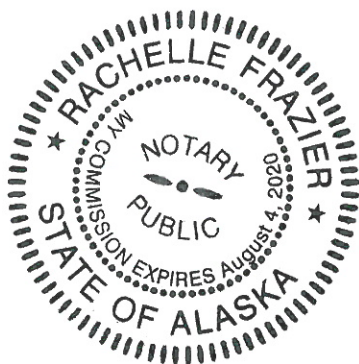

We have a street light erected on electric pole which light up entire area. Lights are installed at all entrances, interior and exterior.

Alarm sensors are installed at all exterior doors and windows. When sensor is broken alarm system is activated and an extremely loud bell goes off.

All areas of growing and harvesting will be monitored with video surveillance system. During harvest no individual is to be alone with product. Owner will monitor all activity.

We are in a very remote location. I do not believe loitering will be a problem. If an individual or group of individuals are loitering on my property they will be hastily removed. No Trespassing - Private Property

We have motion detector to activate all exterior lights on building. Two locked gates will be installed before access to locked doors on growing facility can obtained.

All records will be kept in a secure filing system, in fireproof safe.

Quarterly all paper files are to be digitally recorded - files will be stored onsite and also stored on the cloud service operated by Microsoft Corporation.

The surveillance system will store up to one terabyte of video. Weekly this will be backed up on digital files to be kept onsite and also uploaded to "the cloud."

Receipts of sales - and expenditures will be kept manually and stored in secure filing system - but will also be kept track of digitally onsite and stored in "the cloud"

Video system will track plant from planting till harvest. Upon harvest ~~the~~ each plant will be individually tracked as pertaining to finished product and accumulated waste. Inventory shall be videotaped and the recorded into ledgers. Ledgers will also be digitally recorded as to ease the sharing of information to appropriate entities. Ledgers shall be kept in secure filing system. I understand that the board

has implemented a system metric to track and share this information - I am 100% in favor of using this system to track and share this information.

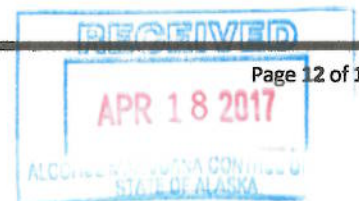

Describe how marijuana or marijuana product will be prepared, packaged, and secured for shipment:

Marijuana product will be segregated by strain and packaged into clear resealable container not exceeding one ounce for delivery to retail outlet that request not rehandling product for sales that require rehandling product will be packaged in resealable containers not exceeding five pounds. All packaged products will be stored in aluminum boxes that will be locked shut. Locked aluminum boxes will be stored in a locked storage area until shipped. All package will be identified with a label generated for the purpose of tracking product, and sharing info with state agencies, and local government.

Describe the type of locked, safe, and secure storage compartments that will be used in any vehicles transporting marijuana or marijuana product:

Storage will be made of 1/4 welded aluminum plate. Two weld on hinges will be attached to the top plate and body of container. The opposing side will have two straps that will be padlocked into place to lock lid onto body of containment box.

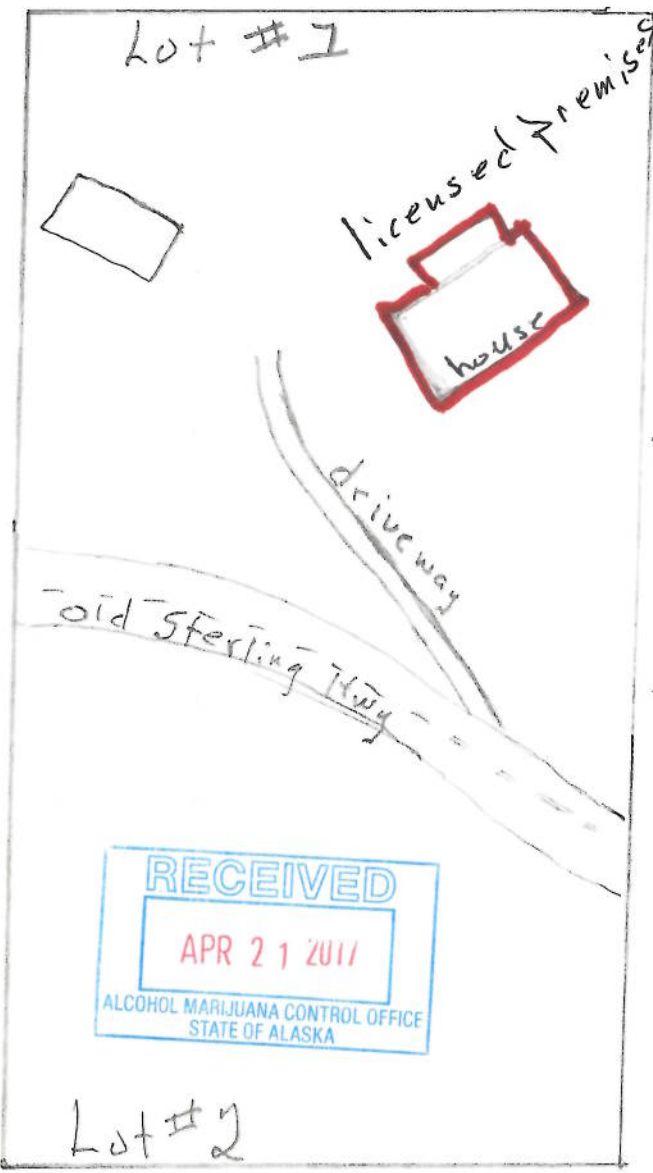

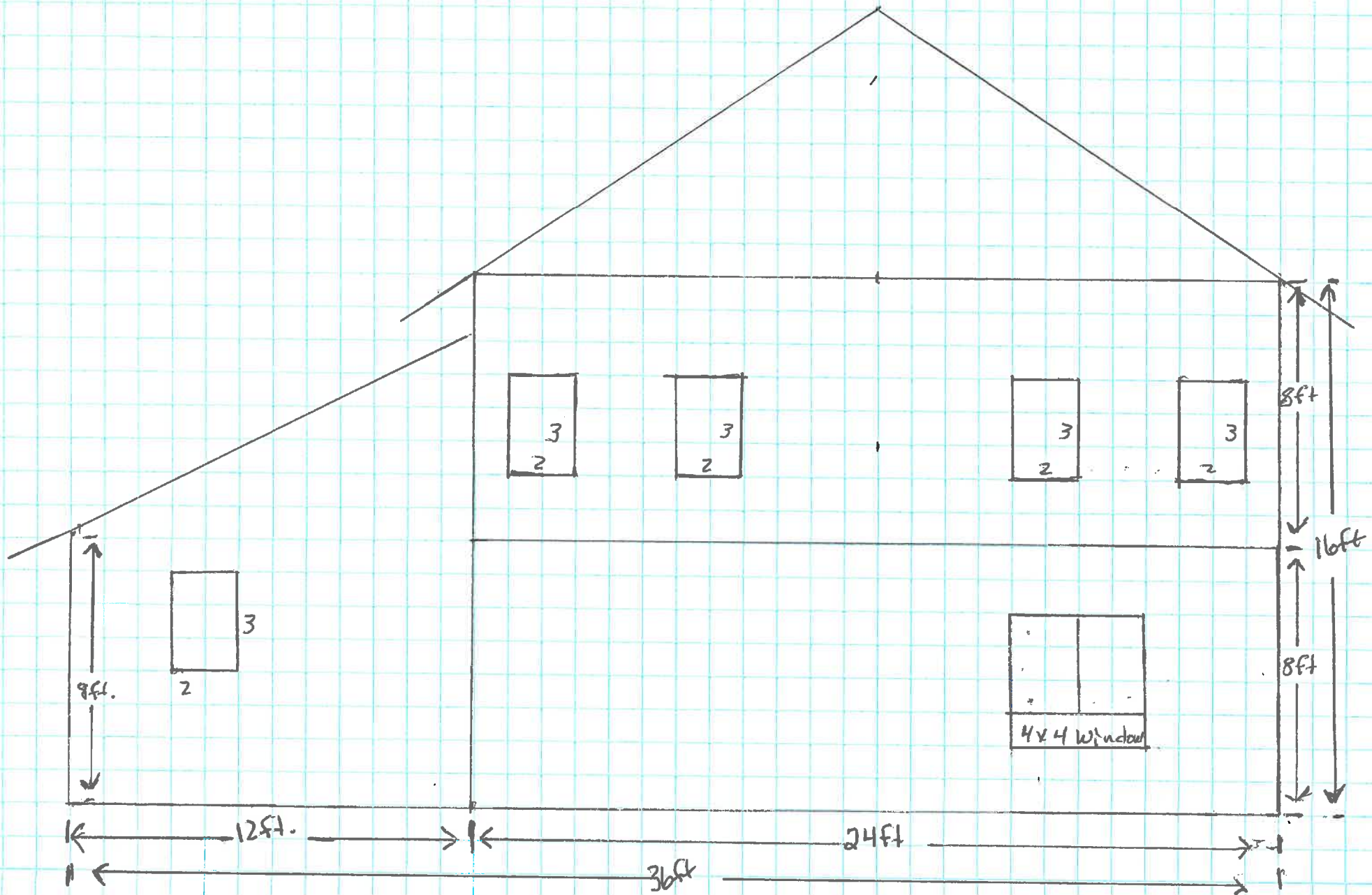
