**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
ORDINANCE 2014-19-56**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND REDIRECTING \$44,987.45 FROM THE U.S. FISH
& WILDLIFE SERVICE, COASTAL IMPACT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM TO THE
AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY PHASE II PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Coastal Impact Assistance Program (CIAP) was established under Section 384 of the Energy Act of 2005 and authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to disburse funds to Outer Continental Shelf oil and gas producing states; and

WHEREAS, the borough approved and appropriated the Aerial Photography/Satellite Imagery project under the CIAP program in the amount of \$499,272 by way of ordinance 2010-19-48; and

WHEREAS, the project was completed and remaining funds deobligated in the amount of \$83,518.80; and

WHEREAS, the borough applied for and has received approval to redirect a portion of the deobligated funds in the amount of \$44,987.45 to complete the Aerial Photography Phase II project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to redirect the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service, Coastal Impact Assistance Program deobligated funds totaling \$44,987.45 to the Aerial Photography Phase II project, project account number 271.21135.15228.49999.

SECTION 2. That the mayor is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to accept and expend the grant, and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriation established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
