FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the planning commission apportionment requirement for first and

2 second class boroughs."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 29.40.020(a) is amended to read:

(a) Each first and second class borough shall establish a planning commission 5 consisting of five residents unless a greater number is required by ordinance. 6 [COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP SHALL BE APPORTIONED SO THAT THE 7 NUMBER OF MEMBERS FROM HOME RULE AND FIRST CLASS CITIES 8 9 REFLECTS THE PROPORTION OF BOROUGH POPULATION RESIDING IN HOME RULE AND FIRST CLASS CITIES LOCATED IN THE BOROUGH.] A 10 member shall be appointed by the borough mayor for a term of three years subject to 11 confirmation by the assembly [, EXCEPT THAT A MEMBER FROM A HOME 12 RULE OR FIRST CLASS CITY SHALL BE SELECTED FROM A LIST OF 13 RECOMMENDATIONS SUBMITTED BY THE COUNCIL]. appointed shall draw lots for one, two, and three year terms. Appointments to fill
vacancies are for the unexpired term. The compensation and expenses of the planning
commission and its staff are paid as directed by the assembly.
