## The Lint on the Bed by Donna Dennis founder of the Anchor Point pantry

"I asked (my husband) Allen if he ever minded when I worked a full shift and then bought and delivered food to families I knew were lacking food at home. He was so emphatic when he answered no and said I reminded him of those people that would bring food to him and his younger sibling when his mom was out.

He said if it wasn't for all of those people, they would have gotten sick or died. I was astonished that any child would have to figure out how to make that gnawing pain of hunger go away and even more shocked to find out it was lint that quieted his stomach."

The Anchor Point Food Pantry is in transition. There are presently 210 households that count on us being here. Our Board is made up of 7 determined women - determined to keep our doors open.
