Assistance to evening students, campus safety enforcement

Veteran Services — College-wide \$88,653

 Certifies veteran students VA eligibility and advises vets and active duty military



Disability Accommodations Coordinator — KRC *\$30,389*

Develops the academic and programmatic accommodations for KRC students who experience disabilities



KPC Recruiter position introduced to FY15 request at 100% KPB funding. FY20 KPB funding reduced to 50%. FY23 KPB funding reduced to 0%.



Financial Aid Disbursements

To date in FY 22, \$849,776 was provided to admitted KPC degree-seeking students after we deduct tuition and fees.

These monies are spent across the Peninsula on housing, food, & other living expenses.
