




Master Facility Planning

Provider Moral Distress & Burnout is Rampant

2020 survey of 1,119 health care workers

86% reported experiencing anxiety
76% reported exhaustion and burnout
75% said they were overwhelmed
55% questioning career path
52% reported compassion fatigue
39% not getting adequate emotional support



8. The Great Resignation, Burnout and Shift to a More Employee-Driven Market

- 598,000 health care workers quit in November 2021
- 18% of health care workers report quitting their job since the start of the pandemic
- 1 in 3 physicians, APPs, and nurses intend to reduce their hours

10. Growth in Temporary Staffing

- The pandemic has dramatically accelerated the growth of the health care staffing industry (valued at \$19.2 billion in 2020)
- The number of temporary health staff grew by 33.3% since 2019
- Temporary staffing industry is expected to grow by 3.7% annually through 2028
 - High labor costs will continue to negatively impact hospital operating margins
 - Maldistribution of providers increases the need for temporary staff, especially in rural areas



Gross Patient Revenue-Q3 YTD FY22



Net Income-Q3 YTD FY22







Salaries, Wages, & Benefits



Salaries, Wages, Benefits as % of Operating Revenue





Change in Net Position


