Re: Mayor's Decision on Appeal

Roads Department, RFP22-044, Summer & Winter Road Maintenance

West Region, Unit 6

Dear Mr. Smith:

The Borough received your May 12, 2022, appeal of the Borough's Intent to Award a contract to Alaska Scrap and Recycling ("the Bidder") for the West Region, Unit 6 Summer and Winter Road Maintenance. The purpose of this letter is to provide my decision on your appeal.

You raised six reasons for the appeal which I have reviewed and which are summarized as follows:

- 1. That the Bidder committed a bid error by submitting their bid on page 2 of 2 of the bid form for Unit 5.
- 2. The instructions to bidders for item 10 states, in part, "only the amounts and information asked for on the Bid Schedule will be considered as the bid. Each bidder shall bid upon the work exactly as specified and as requested on the Bid Schedule" and because of this the Bidder did not bid the work exactly as specified.
- 3. The Bidder did not properly acknowledge the Addendums issued for this project.
- 4. Incorporation of Bid documents into the contract creates a dilemma for KPB: 1) KPB drafts a contract for West Region, Unit 6 using the Bidder's bid using a West Region, Unit 5 Bid form; or 2) KPB asks the Bidder to submit a revised bid using the West Region, Unit 6 Bid Form; or 3) KPB creates its own copy of West Region, Unit 6 Bid Form using the Bidder's numbers. Any of those choices would constitute falsification of documents and a fraudulent contract.
- 5. KPB failed to notify D&L Construction or any other contractors of the bid error.

6. Confusion regarding the Bidder's business license.

Summary of Decision on Appeal

Reason 1: References to Section 10 are noted and bidders should be aware of complications that may lead to a rejection of their bid. Section 13 Acceptance – Rejection of Bids, states that, "The Borough reserves the right to reject any or all bids, **to waive minor irregularities in any bids or in the bidding procedure, and to accept any bid presented which meets or exceeds said specifications and which is deemed to be in the best interest of the Borough.** Please see KPB Code of Ordinances, section 5.28.240 – Waiver of irregularities, emphasis added.

In this instance the Bidder mistakenly submitted sheet two of the bid form on the Unit 5 page 2 of 2. The signature page of this bid was appropriately submitted on sheet 1 of 2 for Unit 6. The Bidder's intention is clearly indicated by their submission and signature on the bid form for Unit 6, page 1 of 2. It is also important to note that the Bidder stated their intention to submit a bid for Unit 6 at the bid opening, immediately upon the reading of their bid.

Reason 2: The pages 2 of 2 in the ITB for all three Units' bid forms are identical with the exception of the noted Unit in the title block on each sheet. The Bid Schedule on the Unit 5 bid form page 2 of 2 is exactly the same as the bid schedule on the Unit 6 bid form page 2 of 2 and would not alter the values in any way.

Reason 3: Based on the recommendation of the Purchasing and Contracting Director, it is reasonable to assume that three check boxes on the Bid Form for Unit 6 serve to acknowledge the Bidder's acceptance of the three addendums issues for this ITB. All addenda will be included in the contract documents upon award.

Reason 4: This is acknowledged as a minor irregularity. Clarification of the intent will be addressed through the contract award process.

Reason 5: On May 6, 2022, at 2:44 pm, and prior to the intent to award, the Purchasing and Contracting Director responded to a request from D&L Construction about the ITB22-044 bid opening (attached). The body of the email stated the following;

"Upon further review of the bid documents the signature page of the bid was in fact for Unit 6. The error was in the use of the bid sheet for Unit 5. That bid sheet is identical to the Unit 6 sheet in format and does not alter the value provided. It was apparent through the signature page and the response from the contractor at the bid opening that the intent was to submit a bid for Unit 6. This is a minor irregularity and is not cause for finding Alaska Scrap and Recycling's bid nonresponsive."

This email also included a copy of the Bid Form pages 1 of 2 and 2 of 2, for reference.

As such, the Borough did respond to D&L regarding the minor irregularity in the bid process. All other claims under this Section are addressed in the explanations above.

Reason 6: The Bidder currently operates three other Roads Service Area Winter and Summer Maintenance contracts under the licensing provided in the bid tab. No discrepancies with that existing licensing status are known to exist at this time.

Therefore, for the reasons stated, your appeal is denied. The decision to award this contract to Alaska Scrap and Recycling is upheld pending inspection and ability to fully comply with the requirements of the contract. March 18, 2022.

This denial constitutes a final action by the Mayor and is appealable to the Borough assembly pursuant to KPB 5.28.320(G). A copy of KPB 5.28.320 is attached to this decision. Pursuant to KPB 5.28.320(G), if you decide to appeal this decision to the assembly you must submit your appeal to the borough clerk in writing within three (3) business days of the date of this decision.

Dear Mayor Pierce,

In accordance with the KPB Code of Ordinances 5.28.320 we hereby appeal the **INTENT TO AWARD** dated May 9, 2022 to Alaska Scrap & Recycling for the Invitation to Bid – ITB 22-044 Summer & Winter Maintenance, West Region, Unit 6.

D & L Construction Co., Inc. was the lowest, qualified, responsive and responsible bidder for this project and should be awarded the contract for the following reasons:

- 1) Alaska Scrap & Recycling did not submit a bid for West Region, Unit 6 regardless of their stated intent after the bid opening. Page 2 of 2 as evidenced by their bid was for West Region, Unit 5 (see attached). They committed a bid error and should not have been declared the low bidder for West Region, Unit 6. Alaska Scrap & Recycling should not be allowed to benefit from their bid error at the expense of other bidders. The Instructions to Bidders, Item 10, states, in part, "Bids may be rejected if they show any omissions, alteration of the forms, additions not called for, conditional or alternate bids not called for, qualified bids, or irregularities of any kind." The Alaska Scrap & Recycling bid omitted the proper Bid Form, page 2 of 2 and therefore constituted an irregularity of the magnitude such that their bid should have been (be) declared nonresponsive for West Region, Unit 6. This contract should be awarded to D & L Construction Co., Inc.
- 2) The Instructions to Bidders, Item 10, states, in part, "Only the amounts and information asked for on the Bid Schedule will be considered as the bid. Each bidder shall bid upon the work exactly as specified and as requested on the Bid Schedule ..." Alaska Scrap & Recycling did not submit a bid with the amounts and information asked for on the Bid Schedule for West Region, Unit 6. Alaska Scrap & Recycling did not bid upon the work exactly as specified and as requested on the Bid Schedule for West Region, Unit 6 therefore their bid is nonresponsive and should have been (be) declared as such. This contract should be awarded to D & L Construction Co., Inc.

- 3) Alaska Scrap & Recycling did not properly acknowledge the Addendums issued for this project. Three Addendums were issued (see attached) prior to bid opening and they should have been acknowledged on the Bid Form, page 1 of 2, as such; i.e., 1, 2 & 3. Instead they appear to have been acknowledged as X X X (see attached). There were no X X X Addendums. Any subsequent contract entered into after award that changes the X X X Addendums to 1, 2 & 3 will not represent the bid as submitted and any changes to reflect the actual Addendums 1, 2 and 3 will constitute the falsification of documents and be fraudulent. This contract should be awarded to D & L Construction Co., Inc.
- 4) Any contract awarded pursuant to the KPB INTENT TO AWARD dated May 9, 2022 to Alaska Scrap & Recycling creates a dilemma for the KPB. One of two things will have to take place. The KPB may draft a contract using the Alaska Scrap & Recycling bid, in which case, a contract will be awarded for West Region, Unit 6 using a West Region, Unit 5 Bid Form. This will in effect create a fraudulent contract. On the other hand the KPB could request Alaska Scrap & Recycling to submit a revised bid using the West Region, Unit 6 Bid Form or the KPB could simply create their own copy of the West Region, Unit 6 Bid Form using the Alaska Scrap & Recycling numbers. In either case, this will constitute not only the falsification of documents but will again create a fraudulent contract. D & L submitted the lowest responsive bid and no falsification of documents or fraud would be involved in awarding them the contract for West Region, Unit 6.
- 5) The construction industry standard requires a fair and open competitive bidding process. The KPB failed in their duty to formally disclose the Alaska Scrap & Recycling bid error for West Region, Unit 6. The KPB did not notify D & L or, to the best of our knowledge, any other contractors, of the bid error. D & L was informed of the bid error by another bidder who was present at the bid opening. This conduct on behalf of the KPB is totally unacceptable and creates a very dangerous precedent for the KPB and all contractors who bid on KPB projects in the future. There appears to be a total lack of integrity on the part of the KPB when it comes to bid openings. KPB Purchasing & Contracting published a false and fraudulent bid tabulation for the West Region, Unit 4, 5 and 6 when they posted the Alaska Scrap & Recycling bid as being for West Region, Unit 6 when it was submitted on the Bid Form for West Region, Unit 5. Withdrawing the INTENT TO AWARD to Alaska Scrap & Recycling for the West Region, Unit 6 contract and awarding the contract to D & L will restore the integrity to this bid opening.
- 6) And finally, there is some question as to whom the KPB would be contracting with if they award this contract to Alaska Scrap & Recycling. Alaska Scrap & Recycling, LLC (1008882) does have a business license (982866) with an address of 720 E Whitney Road Anchorage, Alaska 99501 and a contractor's license (CONE38698) DBA S & R Enterprises (an involuntarily dissolved Alaska business corporation) with an Anchorage, Alaska address. However, the bid submitted by Alaska Scrap & Recycling for West Region, Unit 5 contains two different addresses. The Bid Form, page 1 of 2, has an address of 42462 K Beach Road (which according to KPB records is owned by SAS LLC) Soldotna, Alaska 99669 and the Tax Compliance Certification submitted has an address of 720 E Whitney Road Anchorage, Alaska 99501. The address at 42462 K Beach Road Soldotna, Alaska 99669 shows Alaska Scrap and Recycling as well as Peninsula Scrap & Salvage Co (another involuntary dissolved Alaska business corporation). This contract should be awarded to D & L Construction Co., Inc. who has maintained the same address in the KPB for nearly forty years.

Based upon all the reasons stated above we hereby request that the NOTICE OF AWARD to Alaska Scrap & Recycling for the Invitation to Bid – ITB22-044 Summer & Winter Maintenance West Region, Unit 6 be withdrawn and that the contract be awarded to D & L Construction Co., Inc.



First off I want to say I have nothing against Paul or Alaska Scrap and this is not their fault. This decision on the part of the Borough does not affect me in any way at this point, however the precedent that it set affects every contractor in the Borough in the future. I am absolutely appalled at the Borough's lack of ethics in this matter. Any government organization should be above reproach when it comes to issuing contracts. Alaska Scrap did not bid on W6 at all. Their intention to bid on W6 is irrelevant. They bid on W5. Their is no provision in the contract for a contractor or the Borough to switch which unit a bid is applied to after the fact. There can be no grey area in public bidding like that. There can be no preferential treatment given to one contractor, even if it financially benefits the Borough. The Borough cannot let its financial struggles affect its moral and ethical compass. What is even worse is if I had not been in the room during the bid opening the Borough would have been able to quietly and secretly sweep this under the rug with D&L, the real low bidder, being none the wiser. I feel for Alaska Scrap, I really do. Any contractor that has been doing this any length of time has made mistakes on bids and had to live with it. It is part of the business.

I really hope D&L does not let this precedent stand without a fight. I will gladly stand by their side in this and give my first hand testimony in court or to the media or however they see fit to pursue this.
