KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2021-19-54

AN ORDINANCE REDIRECTING SOLID WASTE CAPITAL PROJECT FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR A DEMOLITION PROJECT TO AN AREAWIDE SOLID WASTE FACILITY LIGHTING UPGRADE PROJECT

- WHEREAS, during the FY2021 annual budget process, the Assembly appropriated funds of \$110,000 for the demolition of obsolete facilities capital project; and
- **WHEREAS**, the demolition and all associated project expenditures have been bid out and are scheduled to be completed by August 31, 2022, leaving \$90,000 in available funds; and
- WHEREAS, the Borough's Solid Waste Department and Risk Department have assessed the solid waste facilities borough-wide and determined a need to replace and upgrade the existing lighting to improve energy efficiency and safety; and
- WHEREAS, this ordinance appropriates \$90,000 from a previously appropriated project in the Solid Waste Capital Project to an Areawide Solid Waste Facility Lighting Upgrade Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the sum of \$90,000 is deobligated from the Solid Waste Demolition of Obsolete Facilities Capital Project and appropriated to account 411.32122.22LIT.49999 to support the Areawide Solid Waste Facility Lighting Project.
- **SECTION 2.** That the appropriations made in this ordinance are of a project length nature and as such do not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.
- **SECTION 3.** That this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its enactment.
