NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That in Assembly District 3, Jesse J. Bjorkman was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 2. That in Assembly District 4, Tyson Cox was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 3. That in Assembly District 7, Brent Johnson was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 4. That in the Board of Education District 1, Patricia Truesdell was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 5. That in the Board of Education District 6, Virginia Morgan was elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 6. That in the Board of Education District 9, John “Zen” Kelly was elected to a 3-year term having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 7. That in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, James M. Sheehan was elected to Seat B for a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

SECTION 8. That in the Joint Operations Board for Central Peninsula Emergency Medical Service Area, the following were elected having received the greatest number of votes cast:

Seat A – Steve Tachick for a 3-year term

Seat B – Ralph Linn for a 3-year term

SECTION 9. That in the Nikiski Senior Service Area Board Area, the following were elected having received the greatest number of votes cast:

SECTION 14. That in the South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area, the following were elected having received the greatest number of votes cast:

Seat G – Tim Daugharty for a 3-year term

Seat H – Amber Cabana for a 3-year term

Seat I – Ralph Broshes for a 3-year term

SECTION 15. That Proposition No. 1 – Apportionment of the Assembly and Board of Education, the voters of the borough chose Plan 1: Nine (9) single member districts.

SECTION 16. That Proposition No. 2 – Educational Capital Improvement General Obligation Bonds, was ratified by the voters.

SECTION 17. That Proposition No. 3. – Central Emergency Service Area General Obligation Bonds and Approval of Project, was ratified by the voters.


SECTION 18. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.


