NOW THEREFORE, THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH DECLARES:

- Section 1. That in the boroughwide election for two Board of Education members, Joyce Fischer and Wayne Kessler were elected having received the highest vote tallies of five candidates and in excess of 40 percent of the vote.
- Section 2. That in the boroughwide election the Proposition approving construction of a new elementary school in Seward, Alaska was approved by the voters.
- Section 3. That in Assembly District 2, Stan A. "Sam" McLane was elected to a second 3 year term in Seat B.
- Section 4. That in Assembly District 3, Betty J. Glick was elected to a third 3 year term in Seat E.
- Section 5. That in Assembly District 4, Brentley D. Keene was elected to a third 3 year term in Seat B, and Charles "Al" Poindexter was elected to a 3 year term in Seat C.
- $\underline{\text{Section 6}}$. That in the Bear Creek Fire Service Area, Clara M. Fultz was elected to a second 3 year term in Seat C, and Dewey J. Smith was elected to a three year term in Seat D.
