A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION WITH THE WILDFIRE RESEARCH CENTER TO CONDUCT WILDFIRE RISK ASSESSMENTS IN THE COMMUNITIES OF COOPER LANDING, FUNNY RIVER AND NIKISKI

- **WHEREAS,** the Wildfire Research Center ("WiRē") is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization dedicated to working with wildfire practitioners to support the creation of fire-adapted communities; and
- **WHEREAS,** WiRē received funding to collect and interpret data that informs decisions about wildfire adaptation for selected communities on the Kenai Peninsula; and
- **WHEREAS,** due to historical fires as well as potential wildland fire risks, the unincorporated communities of Cooper Landing, Funny River and Nikiski were selected as part of the study areas; and
- **WHEREAS,** the value of the in-kind services provided by WiRē is \$158,000, including personnel, resources and outreach materials; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the Borough's best interest to participate in the WiRē study;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the Borough Mayor is authorized to provide assessing and GIS data to support the study areas of Cooper Landing, Funny River and Nikiski.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Borough Mayor is authorized to appoint the Central Emergency Services Fire Chief, Nikiski Fire Chief and the Emergency Manager as project designees to execute a memorandum of agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to fulfill the intents and purposes of this resolution.
- **SECTION 3.** That this resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
