- WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities ("DOT&PF") is administering a Transportation Alternatives Program ("TAP") to advance small scale transportation projects that are important to communities; and
- WHEREAS, the Homer Trail Alliance and its partners are working on a TAP project proposal to develop a multi-use non-motorized separated pathway connecting Diamond Creek State Recreation Area with Baycrest Trails and extending the Sterling Highway sidewalk in Homer; and
