On January 10, 2023, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Purchasing & Contracting Department formally solicited proposals for RFP23-009 Seward High School Track. The request for proposals was advertised in the Peninsula Clarion and the Anchorage Daily News on January 10, 2023 and in the Seward Journal on January 11, 2023.

The project invited qualified firms to submit proposals for professional design & CA services for removal/replacement of the existing track and field, grading and base construction for a new eight lane track, artificial turf field, end zone lettering, drainage and site work/renovations. Construction of perimeter sub drain and drywell system as needed. Grading and paving of the pedestrian access to the track is also included.

On the due date of January 31, 2023, one (1) proposal was received and reviewed by the Purchasing Department.
