SUBJECT:	<b>Chesley Substitute Amendment #5</b> Amending Ordinance 2022-36, Amending KPB 21.29, KPB 21.25, and KPB 21.50.055 Regarding Conditional Land Use Permits and Material Site Permits, Updating Notice, Applicability, Permit Types, Application Requirements, Standards and Permits Conditions (Johnson, Chesley)

[Please note the bold underlined language is new and the strikeout language in brackets is to be deleted.]

Amend KPB 21.29.130, as follows:

21.29.130. Definitions.

A. <u>Unless the context requires otherwise, the following definitions apply to material site permits</u> <u>and activities:</u>

...

<u>Camp or camping means to use a vehicle, tent, or shelter, or to arrange bedding, or</u> both, with the intent to stay overnight.

*Campsite* means any space designated for camping within a public campground.

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<u>Public campground means an area, developed and maintained by a public entity, that</u> is open to the public and contains one or more campsites.

...

*Reclamation* means the process of restoring land that has been mined to a natural or economically-usable state in order to meet a variety of goals ranging from the restoration of productive ecosystems to the creation of industrial and municipal resources.
