RE:	LAYDOWN Cox Amendment #1 to Resolution 2023-60, Recommending an Amendment to Title 14 of the Alaska Statutes, Relating to School Boards, to Allow for Term Limits for School Boards (Derkevorkian)

The recently filed ballot initiative to establish term limits for the Alaska State Legislature was disqualified by the Alaska lieutenant governor based on procedural grounds but also due to the Department of Law finding that the measure was likely unconstitutional. Therefore, it's appropriate to remove the fifth whereas clause indicating that a ballot measure, if approved, could set term limits for the Legislature.
