

What we've accomplished this past year

- 36 cubic yards of soil edging the trails
- Installed logo sign at the entrance
- Installed Bike Rack and Signs encouraging its use
- Placed rocks throughout trails donated from nighbor
- Obtained architectural rendering of entrance and Torii gates
- Removed twelve large trailers full of debris
 - Four brought to the Food Bank for their firewood program
 - Eight brought to the slash piles









