




Gross Patient Revenue-Q2 YTD FY24 (in thousands)








Operating Income-Q2 YTD FY24 (in thousands)






Net Income-Q2 YTD FY24 (in thousands)






Cash & Cash Equivalents-Q2 YTD FY24 (in thousands)





Charity Care & Bad Debt-Q2 YTD FY24 (in thousands)








Salaries, Wages, & Benefits (in thousands)








- April 1st 2026 Phase One Completed (13 Rental Units)
- July 1st 2026 Phase Two Completed (12 Rental Units)
