RE: Authorizing the Issuance of a Letter of Non-Objection to the

Marijuana Control Board Regarding the New Retail Store Application

for The Green Anchor, License No. 35466, Anchor Point

KPB 7.30.010 provides that the Assembly shall review and make recommendations to the state on applications for new retail marijuana licenses located within the Borough. Accordingly, the attached application filed by The Green Anchor is submitted to you for review and recommendation.

The Borough Finance Department reviewed the application and has no objection to the new retail license based on unpaid taxes. The Planning Department reviewed the application and has no objection to the new license based on the standards set forth in KPB 7.30.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Assembly approves the issuance of a letter of non-objection to the Alcohol Marijuana Control Office regarding the new retail marijuana license as requested by The Green Anchor with the recommendation that the following conditions be placed on the state license pursuant to 3 AAC 306.060(b):

- 1. The marijuana establishment shall conduct their operation consistent with the site plan submitted to the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
- 2. There shall be no parking in borough rights-of-way generated by the marijuana establishment.
- 3. The marijuana establishment shall remain current in all Kenai Peninsula Borough tax obligations consistent with KPB 7.30.020(A).
