




- A very successful year in the cannabis industry

- Violent crime is down 2.4%






MORE STATISTICS.....

REVENUE

- Eight months since legalization Colorado is seeing record-high sales
- Recreational sales totaled around \$34.1 million in August, up from \$29.3 million in July
- In total, Colorado has collected
 \$45,200,000 in revenue in the first 8 months after legalization

- As of May 1, 2014, Colorado has licensed 200 retail dispensaries
- 10,043

- More than a thousand people lined up

- As the industry evolves, as will the positions within it





- Charlotte Figi, 6, has DravetSyndrome
- 300 daily seizures
