- **WHEREAS,** Bob was born in Anaheim, California, where he got his start in the oilfield business after high school. Bob's interest in flying began while working on an oil rig in California, which led him to earn his private license and purchase a Piper Tri-Pacer; and
- **WHEREAS,** Bob Bielefeld founded Kenai Aviation in 1961, providing flight instruction and continuous statewide air service supporting oil and gas exploration and production in Cook Inlet; and
- **WHEREAS,** in 2013, the Federal Aviation Administration recognized Bob Bielefeld with inclusion into the prestigious FAA Airmen Certification Database for exceeding the high educational, licensing, and medical standards established by the FAA; and
- **WHEREAS,** throughout his career, Bob logged 42,000 hours as a pilot and as a flight examiner licensed over 400 new pilots; and
- **WHEREAS,** in addition to his aviation career, Bob served on the Kenai City Council from 1966 to 1974 and on the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly from 1967 to 1972;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:
