KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 2016-018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION BY DONATION OF 0.69 ACRES OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE ANCHOR POINT AREA ON BEHALF OF THE ANCHOR POINT FIRE AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE AREA

- WHEREAS, the Anchor Point Fire & Emergency Medical Service Area (APFEMSA) provides for fire protection and emergency medical services within the service area boundary; and
- WHEREAS, the owner of subject property has offered to donate the property which is within the APFEMSA boundaries; and
- WHEREAS, subject property lies adjacent to the Anchor Point Fire Station on Milo Fritz Avenue and would be used by the APFEMSA for non-hostile fire training exercises and future expansion of its facilities; and
- WHEREAS, the APFEMSA board at its meeting of October 21, 2015, recommended to move forward with subject acquisition; and
- **WHEREAS,** the KPB Planning Commission, at its regularly scheduled meeting of March 14, 2016, recommended approval by unanimous consent;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the acquisition of the following described real property on behalf of the Anchor Point Fire & Emergency Medical Service Area is in the best interest of the borough:

Beginning at the East 1/16th Corner of Section 4, Township 5 South, Range 15 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence S 45° 00' W 42.42' to the point of beginning; thence S 00° 01' E 150.00'; thence West 200.00'; thence N 00° 01' W 150.00'; thence East 200.00' to the point of beginning. (Assessor Parcel No. 169-050-18)

SECTION 2. That the terms and conditions substantially in the form of the Purchase Agreement accompanying this resolution are hereby approved. The purchase price shall be one dollar (\$1.00) plus closing costs not to exceed six hundred dollars (\$600). The borough shall also pay an amount equal to the 2016 property taxes on this property.

- SECTION 3. That this acquisition is for non-hostile fire training and other Anchor Point Fire and Emergency Medical Service Area purposes.
- **SECTION 4.** That the proposed classification of this land is government.
- **SECTION 5.** That the Mayor is authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to purchase the real property described in Section 1 in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in this resolution and the accompanying Purchase Agreement, consistent with applicable provisions of KPB Chapter 17.10.
