AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$114,069.36 TO FULLY FUND THE 35 PERCENT MATCH FOR DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SALMON CREEK 205 SECTION PROJECT PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT APPROVED BY RESOLUTION 2015-035

- WHEREAS, the mission of the Seward-Bear Creek Flood Service Area (SBCFSA) is to provide flood planning, protection, and mitigation services in coordination with appropriate agencies to reduce the risk of flood damage to private and public property through addressing issues that best reflect a fair use of the tax levy for watershed-wide benefit; and
- WHEREAS, Resolution 2015-035 authorized the mayor to enter into a Project Partnership Agreement with the United States Army Corps of Engineers for the Design and Construction of the Upper Salmon Creek Revetment, Section 205 Flood Risk Management Design and Implementation phase (Project Partnership Agreement) and approved the required 35 percent match of \$1,160,000; and
- WHEREAS, the Project Partnership Agreement was fully executed May 11th, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, the SBCFSA fund balance of \$114,069.36 was put into reserve for the purpose of fully funding the remaining balance of the 35 percent match; and
- WHEREAS, the SBCFSA at its regular meeting on May 4, 2015 recommended approval to fund the required 35 percent match with the balances remaining to come from its fund balance in the amount of \$114,069.36;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That \$114,069.36 is appropriated from the SBCFSA reserved balance 259.00000.00000.27900 to account 259.21212.00000.43011 for costs associated with fully funding the Project Partnership Agreement.
- **SECTION 2**. That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
