**Subject: Card Street Debris Removal - Reimbursement Approval**

The State of Alaska, Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Management "State Public Assistance Program" made reimbursement in the amount of \$4,600.54 for debris removal costs occurring July 11-25, 2015 resulting from the Card Street Wildfire. These costs were associated with site preparation and dumpster placements at two right-of-ways located at Trout Lane and near the corner of Alamo and Clearing Streets in Sterling. Dumpsters were provided to households impacted by the fire.

\$1,747.80 RSA Site preparation costs  
\$2,852.74 Solid Waste dumpster rental/disposal  
\$4,600.54 Total reimbursement through AK-15-250 PW479

This does not require an ordinance because the reimbursement is under \$5000, and the "grant reimburses the borough for expenditures previously approved and appropriated by the Assembly" through the budget ordinance O2015-19 (KPB R2000-014 as excerpted).
