WHEREAS, more than 11,200 individuals on the Kenai Peninsula rely on food provided by the members of the Kenai Peninsula Food Bank annually; and

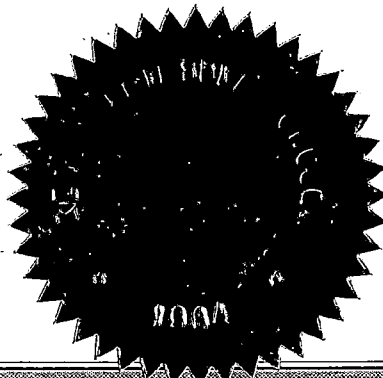


