




# Our Vision

o The vision of Alaska Christian College is to be the premier college of choice for Alaska Native students so that our graduates follow and serve Christ within the Church and larger society.

# A short history- THEN

- o Purchased Ballard property on 10.5 acres with 8,400 sq. ft. admin bldg. from CPCS
- Opened with 22 students from 4 states, 7 ethnic groups, 80% Alaska Native background with 16 self supporting faculty and staff
- o A one year, non-accredited, Bible college for Native young people

# A short history- NOW

o 27.5 acres owned with 15 buildings built in part by volunteer labor each summer o Added a 36 bed dormitory, three cabins, a duplex, New Hope Counseling Center, triplex apts, small chapel, conference center, Classroom building, shop, and car garage

#### A short history- NOW cont.

o 45 full, part time, volunteer and self supported staff and faculty

o 600 students have attended here and at KPC in 15 classes (returning and new)

o Budget has grown from \$500,000 to \$2,350,000

## Continued-NOW

o Earned "Accredited" status with the Association for Biblical Higher Education approved by the US DOE

o Began New Hope Counseling Center in 2003 to address the needs of Alaska's native students attending ACC

o Opened NHCC to community clients in 2006; 3023 clients

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### ACC OFFERS:

o Two AA degrees in Paraprofessional education and Christian Ministry, next Behavorial Health AA degree in 2017

o Residential community living with 74 on campus and 7 commuters

# WHAT WE OFFER- Cont.

o Transitional training and education to prepare them for a four year college and possibly return to Bush Alaska o Life skills and training to be successful in life/society o A personalized approach to education with strong support systems in place

- o A four year college, but a two year o An online college
- o A place where anyone can teach: our classes are taught by master's and doctoral degreed professors
- o A college only for Alaska's natives, we invite all who wish to this unique experience to join us
