SUBJECT:	Ordinance 2016-19-13, Accepting and Appropriating \$104,000 from the Alaska Department of Military and Veteran Affairs, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management to Purchase Radio Consoles (Mayor)	

The borough has received notification from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management ("DHS&EM") that they are increasing the State Homeland Security Program grant 20SHSP-GY16 from \$491,930.94 to \$595,930.94. The additional \$104,000 may be used to purchase radio consoles. Therefore, the revised budget is approved by the state, as follows:
