- WHEREAS, assistance from outside counsel is needed to properly represent the borough in this litigation; and
- WHEREAS, KPB 5.04.095 and KPB 5.04.100 authorize the assembly to transfer by resolution unencumbered balances at the budgetary control level, which is at the department level for the general fund; and
- WHEREAS, funds are available in the mayor's department for transfer to the legal department to help pay costs associated with this litigation;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

**SECTION 1.** The assembly hereby transfers \$50,000 in unencumbered funds from the mayor's department to the legal department account 100.11310.00000.43011, contract services, to cover legal costs and expenses associated with defending the borough in litigation challenging the assembly invocation policy.


