## AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$193.03 IN RESIDUAL FUND BALANCE FROM THE FORMER LOWELL POINT EMERGENCY FIRE SERVICE AREA TO THE **BOROUGH'S GENERAL FUND**

WHEREAS, the Lowell Point Emergency Service Area ("Service Area") voters voted to abolish the Service Area effective June 30, 2012 at the October 4, 2011 borough election; and

WHEREAS, the former Service Area has residual fund balance of \$193.03 from the collection of property taxes that were previously not appropriated; and

WHEREAS, as the Service Area no longer exists and it was part of the borough, the remaining assets and liabilities revert to the borough; and

**WHEREAS**, the fund balance should therefore be transferred to the General Fund;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI **PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


