SUBJECT: Ordinance 2016-19-<u>37</u>, Redirecting Funds Previously Appropriated for Various South Peninsula Hospital Equipment Purchases and Authorizing the Purchase of Other Needed Equipment (Mayor)

The South Peninsula Hospital ("SPH") has identified a number of capital projects that are complete and is requesting the unspent funds be redirected for the purchase of various equipment.

The completed projects include:

- project number 491.81210.8SH01.48516 emergency equipment with a remaining balance of \$62,669.55
- project number 491.81210.15SHN.48516 for miscellaneous equipment with a remaining balance of \$106,797.81
- project number 491.81210.16SHS.48516 for various equipment with a remaining balance of \$177,891.82

SPH is requesting the total unspent funds of \$347,359.18 from the above project be used for the purchase of the following equipment:

- two Cystoscope instrument that are needed by SPH to bring them up to date with current equipment with an estimated cost of \$80,000
- gynecological ("GYN") instruments needed by SPH OB/GYN surgeons to meet the increased utilization and scheduling of GYN surgeries and to address the use of current sterilization practices with an estimated cost of \$30,000
- an ER Ultrasound unit to improve patient care with an estimated cost of \$50,000

- relocation and renovation of the sleep lab which will also provide additional space for behavioral health with an estimated cost of \$75,000
- replacement of the current treadmill used to perform stress test with an estimated cost of \$26,500
- other minor equipment including wheelchairs, beds, crash cart, freezer, automatic doors, medical recliners, EKG machine and front wheel drive car for SPH and traveler use totaling approximately \$85,859.18

Purchasing the equipment aligns with the following strategies from the South Peninsula Hospital Strategic Plan:

1) "Maintain and enhance the reputation of SPH by focusing on services and clinical excellence"

2) "Continuously improve organizational performance throughout the hospital, including quality improvement, control of infection, assessment of patients and care of patients"

3) "Provide services that increase utilization of SPHI as a first choice medical facility and service point in the service area"
