Beginning on June 15, 2015 a series of wildfires occurred in the Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) as a result of prolonged hot, dry weather. The most significant of these is the Card Street Wildfire which began on June 15 and damaged 11 buildings in Sterling, including 3 primary residences. A federal Fire Management Grant (FMAG) has been authorized to assist in the cost of suppression. This PW includes costs related to elimination and lessening of immediate threats to public health and safety, and threats of damage to improved public and private property. In order to provide a coordinated and efficient response to the situation, the KPB activated their Emergency Operations Center in response to these wildfires.
