- Located in the Sea Otter Community Center, adjacent to Susan B English School
- Mill rate
 - NPR .75 mills; total revenue of approximately \$56,000
- Contract with the City of Seldovia for administration, janitorial and programming services

FY2017 Key Accomplishments

- New facility coordinator was hired and increased weekly hours from 20 to 29
- Replacement of 4 board members since last year
- New management agreement was approved with the City of Seldovia
- Operations:
 - Women's & girls basketball program
 - Senior exercise program three days a week
 - Craft programs including sewing
 - Open hours
