## KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2016-19-31

## AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING \$37,500 FROM THE U.S. FISH AND WILDLIFE SERVICE, PARTNERS IN FISH WILDLIFE PROGRAM TO SUPPLEMENT THE DONALD E. GILMAN RIVER CENTER PUBLIC FISHING AREA **RESTORATION PROJECT**

- WHEREAS, the Donald E. Gilman River Center ("River Center") includes a public fishing area along the Kenai River bank, which is in need of restoring the anadromous habitat; and
- WHEREAS, the borough received award notification from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Partners in Fish and Wildlife Program ("Program") to supplement the restoration project in the amount of \$37,500; and
- WHEREAS, the program requires a 50 percent cash match in the amount of \$37,500, which is available in the approved River Center fiscal year 2017, contract services account; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the borough to accept the grant funds;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** The mayor is authorized to accept the Partners in Fish and Wildlife Project Grant in the amount of \$37,500 from the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That funds in the amount of \$37,500 are appropriated to 100.21135.17BNK.49999, a project account.
- **SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.
