KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ORDINANCE 2016-19-33

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,500 FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT TO PURCHASE GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM SOFTWARE

- WHEREAS, the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program ("HMGP") is a federal pass-through program to supplement critical mitigation projects that limit the loss to life and property in the event of future disasters; and
- WHEREAS, the borough applied for funds to purchase geographic information system ("GIS") software for land cover hazard assessments; and
- WHEREAS, notification has been received from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management that a grant in the amount of \$15,500 has been awarded to purchase the software; and
- WHEREAS, the software will create GIS land cover data that may be used to evaluate hazard and risk information during disaster response, recovery or to substantiate mitigation projects to be completed; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the borough to accept the grant funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to accept a Hazard Mitigation Grant from the Alaska Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management in the amount of \$15,500 to purchase GIS software, and is authorized to execute a grant agreement and any other documents deemed necessary to expend the grant and to fulfill the intents and purposes of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 2.** That funds in the amount of \$15,500 are appropriated to 271.11232.42444.49999, a project account.
- **SECTION 3.** That due to the length and nature of this project, the appropriations established through this ordinance shall not lapse at the end of any particular fiscal year.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
