- **SECTION 1.** That \$25,000 is appropriated from the borough general fund balance to account 100.11310.00000.43011, contract services, to cover legal costs associated with the complaint filed by William Dunne against the Kenai Peninsula Borough and Mayor Mike Navarre.
- **SECTION 2.** That this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.
